

General Data Protection Regulations (“GDPR”) PRIVACY NOTICE FOR INDUSTRY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS AND ATTENDEES

This Privacy Notice summarises how and why NCHSR (“the College”) uses your data and informs you of your rights in relation to it.

The College holds and processes your data so it can fulfil its obligations to you in your capacity as a Member/Attendee of the Industry Advisory Board. In order to be able to communicate with you about College and I.A. Board related matters including meeting and training administration and the circulation of meeting packs, populating the Governance section of the College website (including using photographic images) and, where applicable, pay your expenses, the College holds personal details including your name, gender, date of birth, home and work address and postcode, email address, contact telephone number(s), photograph(s), biography, CV, interests and in some cases, bank account details.

The College is the Data Controller for your data. In the case of expenses payments your data is shared with a third-party Data Processor (currently RSM) to whom the processing of payments is outsourced.

As part of the College’s role in keeping your information safe you need to be aware that you can contact the Head of Governance & Legal whose appointment includes the role of Data Protection Officer (“DPO”) at any time to obtain a copy of the information the College holds about you and to have any inaccuracies corrected. Where appropriate you may have your personal information erased, rectified, transferred or amended.

You do not need to take any action upon receipt of this message as it is sent for information purposes only.
